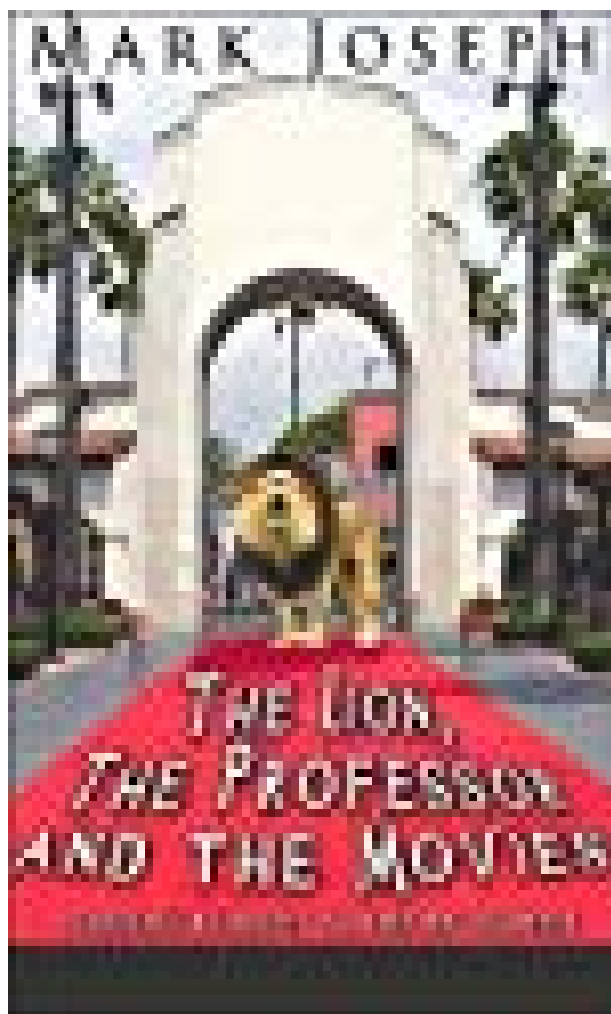


# The Lion, The Professor And The Movies: Narnia's Journey To The Big Screen
